Under the guidance of the Principal of the college, the students performed extremely well in this scheme. Under this scheme, the students worked in Library, Girls Hostels, Solar Panels, Parks, Cleanliness of premises, Laboratories of various subjects, Museum, Horticulture, B.C.A. Lab, office, store room, playground, gymnasium etc. In official work, they understand the nature of work related to distribution of results, cash counter, varsity table. In library, they learn how to tagging, distribution, registration, arrangement of books. Examination Committee

Report of Committee 2022-23

Exams following the CBCS pattern are administered in accordance with Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU), Pune regulations. The institute features a separate examination office that is connected to the internet and has CCTV surveillance. The College Examination Officer (CEO) holds the responsibility of ensuring the seamless, reliable, and open administration of both internal and external examinations inside the institution.

The passing grades for the internal and external exams are different. The purpose of the offline internal exams was to evaluate the students' writing proficiency as well as their aptitude for applying newly learned material. The internal examination question papers are designed with the learning outcomes in mind. To encourage transparency, students' performance was discussed with them in the classroom. To improve the evaluation process's transparency, the results of the internal examination were displayed on the notice board.

70% weightage of the evaluation process is given to external examinations, which were carried out by Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU), Pune. The SPPU, Pune, announces the student results forty days after the exam gets over. They had filed the complaints over the exams through the Student Profile System (SPS) platform and were resolved by the University.
